

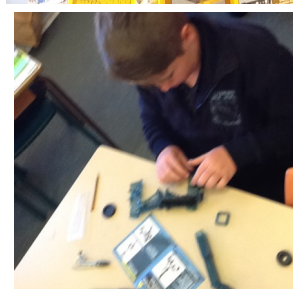
National Science week
