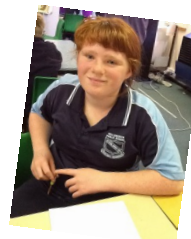

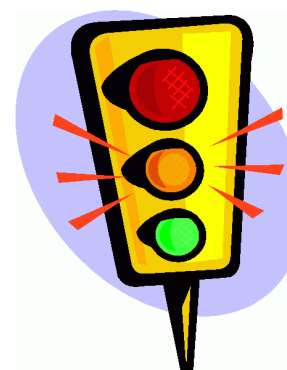
Clippings From The Garden
